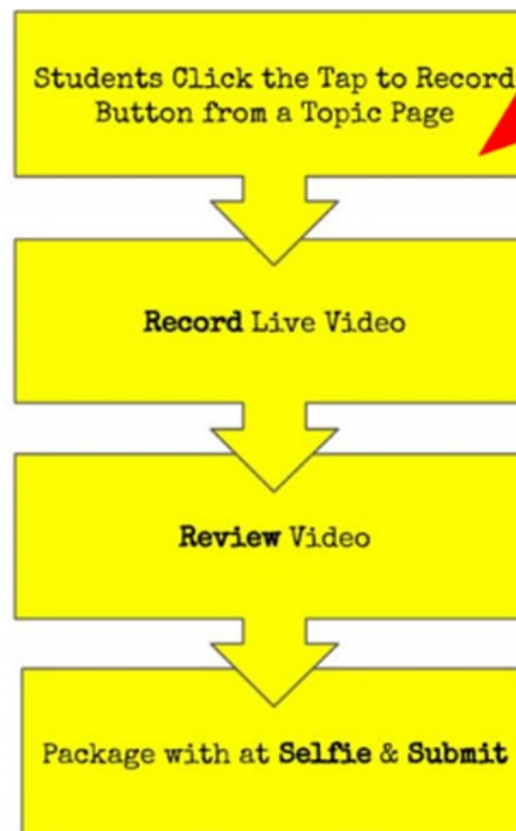


Year 1 - ICT/Computing– Flipgrid



Key Vocabulary	
<i>Flipgrid</i>	An object for a child to play with, typically a model.
<i>topics</i>	Topics are discussion starters or prompts, which the children will respond to.
<i>responses</i>	These are the children's videos they record or upload from an electronic device and add to the topic. This is how they share their voice!
<i>replies</i>	This allows users to add a response or 'reply' to a response that was added to the topic.
<i>Camera (recorder)</i>	Flipgrid has its very own recorder built into the app, to record the content you wish to be filmed.
<i>pause</i>	The recording of the video can be paused at any moment, before continuing with the recording.



Home activities

- Use an electronic device (iPhone, iPad, camera, video recorder) to learn how the basic skills or recording/ photographing.
- Create your own mini movie by recording and pausing video on an electronic device.
- Use the voice notes to help practice your best presenter voice and fluency!

Flipgrid
