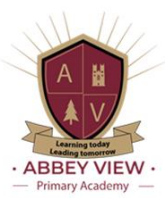


Year 3 Autumn Term Newsletter

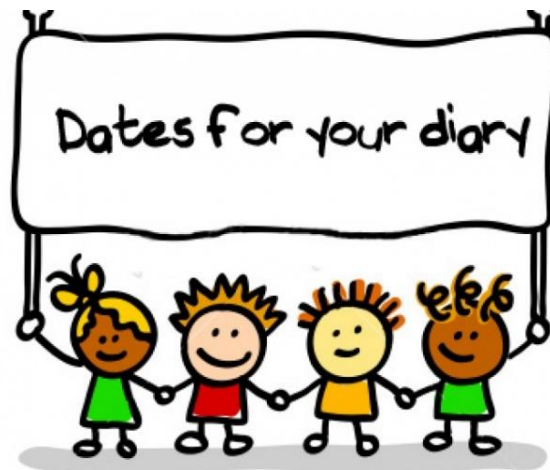

Reading



- Read **daily** with your child and sign their Reading Record
- Ask comprehension questions:
- Ask retrieval questions
- Discuss character's thoughts and feelings
- Make predictions
- Read a range of books- fiction and non-fiction
- Read books from the reading list

Spellings



- Practise Spellings daily

Use the following strategies:

- Look, Cover, Write and Check
- Rainbow words
- Spellings in sentences
- Dictation
